These school improvements are known as the “expected outcomes”.

1. Increased student achievement (measured by test results and grades)
2. Improved student behavior (measured by a reduction in negative behaviors, referrals, detentions, etc.)
3. Improved student and staff attendance
4. Improved staff morale (measured by assessments)
5. Increased parent and community engagement
